Only 6 bottles with the label by Peter Doig are auctioned online!


The wine is paired with paintings donated by upcoming artists from various countries on the theme of wine.

Peter Doig's unique watercolour, which was sold for £40 000 (56 453 Euros), showing the image of the moon in relation to Cælestis biodynamic wine adorns the bottle of vintage 2011.

Specially painted for Caelestis to raise funds for WWF this artwork was kindly donated by this renowned contemporary artist.

Cælestis biodynamic wine originates from the prestigious Château Fonroque Saint-Emilion Grand Cru Classé and is signed by its renowned producer and oenologist Alain Moueix: 'Like an artist who goes beyond his limits to find the breeding ground of his art, the vine draws upon the energy of the stars and from the depths of the earth the sense of the place.'

This fine wine remains a true rarity because among a total of 176 Bordeaux Grands Crus Classés (Classified Growths), there are only 3 biodynamic certified Grands Crus Classés wines (barely 2.27% are organic).

Cælestis is not sold in shops and only a few bottles to share between three continents are auctioned each year, making Cælestis one of the rarest wines in the world.
